ORDER

AND NOW, this 24th day of November, 2009 this ORDER is to be entered and made effective November 27th, 2009

Section 1. Background and Intent.

From time to time it becomes clear that new or modified procedures must be established in order to carry out the legislative intent as indicated in the enabling statute (Act 94 of 2004).

Taxicab owners are responsible for paying an assessment annually. At the request of the Industry, the Philadelphia Parking Authority's Taxicab and Limousine Division (TLD) established four payment periods for owners who do not wish to pay the entire annual assessment at the beginning of the year (due July 1). To prevent long lines on the last day of an assessment period, appointments are scheduled for owners of multiple Medallions and or taxicabs. Many owners do not feel they must come to their appointments as long as they pay by the last day of the assessment period. Due to the limited number of staff devoted to collecting assessments, this becomes unmanageable.

The intent of this Order is to formalize the "Fleet Week" procedure for each assessment period. Appointments will be scheduled by TLD staff members in advance for those companies subject to this Order.

Section 2. Procedure.


For owners of three or more Medallions or partial rights cabs (regardless of corporate title) the "Fleet Week" assessment period is the first week of the following months:

June	December
September	February

Section 3. Notice

The TLD staff is hereby ordered to provide all due and required notice of the issuance of this Administrative Order, including broadcasting by email to all CPC holders, owners and dispatch companies and posting at TLD Headquarters and on the TLD website.
