AND NOW, this 26th day of June, 2009 this ORDER is to be entered and made effective July 1, 2009

Section 1. Background and Intent.

The Philadelphia Parking Authority's Board approved a new Penalty Schedule applicable to the Philadelphia Taxicab and Limousine Industries on July 29, 2008.

From time to time it becomes clear that changes or additions must be made to the existing Penalty Schedule in order to carry out the legislative intent as indicated in the enabling statute (Act 94 of 2004).

At this time, three new violations must be added to the list and one violation must be clarified. All four violations are "Owner Violations".

Additions:

To Section A
