The contractor must submit the Contractor's Quality Control Plan. The plan must include reference to all over site associations referred to in the Contract Documents as they pertain to Quality Control and pertinent Quality Control forms (example: Welding Certificate and Reference Specifications) in order to execute all work as intended in the Bid Documents.
