Proposed Parking Lots At the Ben Franklin Bridge 3rd Street, Philadelphia, PA

Two Prime Contractors, General and Electrical

Sealed Bids will be received until 2:00 PM on Friday, February 3, 2017, by the Philadelphia Parking Authority (“the Authority”), a body corporate and politic created under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in accordance with the Act of June 19, 2001, P.L. 287, No. 22, as amended, known as the “Parking Authority Law”.

Scope of Work

The Delaware River Port Authority (DRPA) owns and operates an interstate bridge crossing, the Benjamin Franklin Bridge, between Philadelphia, PA, and Camden, NJ. The DRPA and the PPA are entering an agreement whereby the PPA would install new revenue collection equipment, fencing, and paving in order to create a new parking lot under the western approach structure of the bridge. The lot will have three entrances to three sections located between 4th and Front Streets, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The Authority intends to engage two prime contractors, a general contractor for the site work, and an electrical contractor for the related electrical services, to perform the construction and installation of the improvements.

The bid documents for this solicitation will be available after 3:00 PM on Friday, January 6, 2017. Interested firms can obtain the documents from Mary Wheeler, Manager of Contract Administration, in the offices of the Authority, located at 701 Market Street, Suite 5400, Philadelphia, PA 19106. The bid documents may be obtained for a fee of \$100.00.

Respondents are required to attend a mandatory pre-bid meeting and site visit on Thursday, January 12, 2017 at 12:30 PM at the project site, Benjamin Franklin Bridge and Third Street, Philadelphia, Pa 19106.

Deadline for questions is Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at 11:00 AM. Proposals are due Friday, February 3, 2017, no later than 2:00 PM.
