Sealed Bids will be received until 2:00 PM on Monday, September 12, 2016, by the Philadelphia Parking Authority (“the Authority”), a body corporate and politic created under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in accordance with the Act of June 19, 2001, P.L. 287, No. 22, as amended, known as the “Parking Authority Law”.

Scope of Work

The Philadelphia Parking Authority owns and operates the parking facilities at the Philadelphia International Airport. The associated facilities consist of seven structured parking garages, a paved surface parking lot, and ancillary structures including three toll plazas, an administration building, and a maintenance garage.

Electrical power to PPA facilities at the airport are fed from approximately 7 high voltage substations. From these substations, power is stepped down to 480 volts for PPA use at approximately 18 locations. Currently these locations are not metered.

The Authority intends to engage a single prime electrical contractor to provide and install new, commercial grade electric meters at all of the 480 volt secondary side feed circuits.

The bid documents for this solicitation will be available after 3:00 PM on Friday, August 12, 2016. Interested firms can obtain the documents from Mary Wheeler, Manager of Contract Administration, in the offices of the Authority, located at 701 Market Street, Suite 5400, Philadelphia, PA 19106. The bid documents may be obtained for a fee of \$100.00.

Respondents are required to attend a mandatory pre-bid meeting and site visit on Friday, August 19, 2016 at 11:00 AM at the offices of the Philadelphia Parking Authority - Airport Operations located at 1 Main Toll Plaza, Philadelphia International Airport, Philadelphia, Pa 19153.

Deadline for questions is Wednesday, August 31, 2016. Proposals are due Monday, September 12, 2016, no later than 2:00 PM.
