

ORDER

AND NOW, this 6<sup>TH</sup> day of October, 2016, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that Plaintiffs' Motion for a injunctive relief is **GRANTED**, for the reasons set forth on the record today and at previous hearings.<sup>1</sup>

1. "TNC" taxi service that provides point to point service in the City of Philadelphia (such as UBER-X and LYFT) violates the civil rights of riders with disabilities in violation of the American Disabilities Act, and the City's Fair Practice Ordinance;
2. Accordingly, such service shall cease and desist within the City of Philadelphia.
3. PPA shall fully enforce under the law its regulations with regard to TNC as unauthorized taxi service within the City of Philadelphia.
4. PPA shall provide a copy of this Order to all TNC taxi companies and operators to whom it may issue citations;
5. Continued violation of this Order may result in contempt of court, upon notice and hearing..
